

## Formed By God / Sanctification

Dec. 18th

**Text: Matthew 1:18-25** 

**Matthew 1:21,** "She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for <u>He will save His people from their sins."</u>

Romans 3:23 ...for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

1 John 1:10 If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

**1 John 2:1** My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.

"Sanctification is that inward spiritual work which the Lord Jesus Christ works in a man by the Holy Spirit, when He calls him to be a true believer." **J.C. Ryle** 

Sanctification is being "separated to God." Sanctification is...

- the power of God that <u>liberates</u> us from the grip of sin
- the power of God that <u>separates</u> you from the corruption of this world
- the power of the Holy Spirit that sets you <a href="mailto:apart">apart</a> for a special purpose
- the invisible <u>work</u> of God transforming ordinary people into the sort of persons who live extraordinary lives by God's power

1 Thess. 4:3 For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you abstain from sexual immorality; 4 that each one of you know how to control his own body in holiness and honor, 5 not in the passion of lust like the Gentiles who do not know God; 6 that no one transgress and wrong his brother in this matter, because the Lord is an avenger in all these things, as we told you beforehand and solemnly warned you. 7 For God has not called us for impurity, but in holiness.

## Two things:

- 1). Jesus' work for holiness in your life is not just about avoiding sins.
- 2). Jesus' work for holiness in your life is about **growing** you toward Him... continually. Creating Kingdom successes/joy/abundance in your life.

**Galatians 5:22** *love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.* 

1 Thessalonians 5:23, Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
