**Key Passage: Luke 1**

The purpose and meaning of God in the flesh:

*A. To bring redemption to those who believe*

v. 68: "He has come to his people and redeemed them."

*B. To have the power to accomplish our salvation through Him*

v. 69. "He has raised up a horn of salvation for us."

*C. Assure victory over our enemies*

v. 71. "He has raised up . . . salvation from our enemies and from the hands of those who hate us"(which is emphasized again in v. 74).

*D. To remember His covenant promise...and fulfill it!*

v. 72 "...to show mercy to our ancestors and to remember his holy covenant."

*E. To empower us to live before Him*

v. 74 & 75 "...to enable us to serve him without fear in holiness and righteousness before him all our days."

*F. To erase all offenses*

v. 77. "To give His people knowledge of salvation through the forgiveness of their sins."
