Key Passage: Luke 1:26-38, 46-55

Because of God's omniscience, you should never set in stone your life plans...because when you think you have it clearly orchestrated...He will change it!

A great truth:

1. Luke 1:37 *"For no word from God will ever fail."*

Two great examples:

2. Luke 1:38 *"I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered.*
3. Luke 1:38b *"May it happen to me just as you said it would."*

1 PETER 2:9 (ESV)

Lessons from Mary's Song:
