Key Passage: John 3:1-15

We are all a lot like Nicodemus.

Nicodemus unpacked:

- 1). We all have a bit of religiousness in us.
- 2). We know **<u>lesus</u>** to an extent—of Him, about Him, regarding Him, of His ways and life.
- 3). We so desperately want to desire Jesus and move beyond our superficial faith.

Living in the 'margins of scripture' is a safe place, where the expectation is not too high a cost. We can feel close to the Lord without the accountability of entering into the narrative.

4). There is a tension and struggle to accept Jesus as Lord!

The Pathway to New Life:

<u>Repentance-</u> turning our heart and mind away from other gods and ourselves and believing in God alone.

<u>Surrender-</u> is accepting Jesus as Savior and choosing to live in His pathway. <u>Lordship-</u> that Jesus is the ruler, the boss, the master of your whole life.

"Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."
