**Key Passage: Acts 9:10-28**

**The Apostle Paul** (Saul) represents the **new** believer with a new direction; a holy zeal for the Kingdom. (vs. 15)

**Ananias** represents to us the **faithful** believer (*He was a disciple of Jesus*) (vs. 13-14)

**Barnabas** represents the **traditional** believers who set aside their tradition for the new and continuing purposes of God. (vs. 27)

**When you invite Jesus into your heart, you must expect change to happen **in** you!**

**When you believe in Jesus through faith, you must expect change to happen **around** you!**

*You cannot live a static life if you are living for Jesus!*

*You cannot be static in your knowledge, discipleship, faith, witnessing, or expectations!*

**When you have faith in Jesus, you must expect change to happen **through** you!**

**Acts 9:31** *So the church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria had peace and was being built up. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it multiplied.*
