

**The Life of Gideon Part 2 - Trust**

***Key Passage: Judges 6:33-7:7***

Gideon teaches us that true courage comes through...

1. Trusting in GOD'S WORD

- “The Lord is with you, O mighty man of valor. Go in this might of yours and save Israel from the hand of Midian. Do not I send you? I will be with you and you shall strike the Midianites as one man.” (Judges 6:12, 14, 16)

2. Being confident in GOD'S CHARACTER

- “Thus says the LORD, the God of Israel: 'I led you up from Egypt and brought you out of the house of slavery. And I delivered you from the hand of the Egyptians and from the hand of all who oppressed you, and drove them out before you and gave you their land. And I said to you, 'I am the LORD your God; you shall not fear the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell.'” (Judges 6:8-10)

3. Entering into a REAL RELATIONSHIP of TRUST with God

- “With the 300 men who lapped I will save you and give the Midianites into your hand, and let all the others go every man to his home.” (Judges 7:7)
- Trust, n. - firm belief in the reliability, truth, or ability of someone or something; confidence or faith in a person or thing, or in an attribute of a person or thing

What might God ask of you in order for you to experience His power?
