How does humanity's story end?

- Science says, "The world ends in entropy and despair."
- Science fiction says, "The world ends in terror and dystopia."
- Christianity says, "The world ends in healing and hope."
 - \Rightarrow The return of Jesus
 - \Rightarrow The removal of human evil
 - \Rightarrow The restoration of the cosmos

"Wherever the river goes, every living creature that swarms will live, and there will be very many fish. For this water goes there, that the waters of the sea may become fresh; so everything will live where the river goes." (Ezekiel 47:9)
