The way one <u>sees</u> the church influences how one <u>behaves</u> and <u>participates</u> within it.

Three images to correct our vision:

- "You are *God's field*.." (1 Corinthians 3:9)
- "God's building..." (1 Corinthians 3:9)
- "Do you not know that you are *God's temple* and that God's Spirit dwells in you?" (1 Corinthians 3:16)

The church is not <u>ours</u>; it's <u>God's</u>. We cannot lay claim to it or redefine its aims and agenda. Jesus has set its mission and foundation in stone.

The church is <u>organic</u> and <u>mysterious</u>. Cultivating this community requires hard work, but ultimately we are dependent upon God to bring life and growth.

The church is an <u>ever-expanding</u> building because our big-hearted God is always making space for more and more people to come and make their home with him.
