Prosperity is temporary—show restraint

Proverbs 23:4 "Do not <u>wear yourself</u> out to become rich; be wise enough to restrain yourself. **5** When you gaze upon riches, they are gone, for they surely make wings for themselves, and fly off into the sky like an eagle!"

Adversity is inevitable—be prepared

2 Timothy 3:2 "Indeed, all who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted..." (ESV) **John 16:33** "In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world."

Effort is essential—don't give up

2 Corinthians 4:16-18

16 "So we do not lose heart. Though our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day. **17** For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison..." (ESV)

Galatians 6:9 "And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up."

Hebrews 10:36 "You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised."

God is faithful—be faithful

Isaiah 43:2 "When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze."

1 Peter 5:10 "And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast."
