Key Passage: Matthew 5:1-12

The beginning of a true disciple starts with—

Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Key phrase: Reliance on God alone.

The following are the results of being poor in spirit—

Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.

Key phrase: Grieve over sin

Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.

Key phrase: Attitude of the soul towards another

Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.

Key phrase: Complete satisfaction of spiritual hunger

Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.

Key phrase: Giving mercy begets mercy!

Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.

Key phrase: Without holiness no one will see the Lord

Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God.

Key phrase: One who takes on Jesus' image

Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Key phrase: Godly life in Christ Jesus

Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. Key phrase: God's calling outweighs
